




The National and Local NGOs started provided support from the beginning by their own fund. Later they received funding from donor/ INGO/ UN and private sector.

140.22 Crore (in BDT)


Funding Amount of NGOs

15.67 Crore (in BDT)


Total COVID-19 Responses Supported by Donors & NGOs (own funding)
