Successful story of Mask making initiative

- ❖ Juynab Bibi 18 years old a Rohingya teenager living with her family since influx in cnp-20Ext.
- ❖ In her family, her elder brother is the only earning person and her father has been suffering from chronic disease.
- ❖ In COVID crisis, they faced severe financial crisis.
- ❖ Mask making initiative by COAST, She equipped and trained on mask making.
- ❖ Now she is making **100 re-usable** mask per day and **earned 500BDT**.
- ❖ Now she is self reliant and support her family.



Challenges for programme

- Community people don't want to wear mask and maintaining social distance is a major challenge
- Due to congested arena, maintaining Social distances is very tough for staff while conducting awareness session
- Child labor has increased in the pandemic situation
- Risk of trafficking and gender based violence has also increased at household and community level
- Youth and adolescents are kept idle and having nothing to do in the pandemic situation that lead to impose in crimes
- Tension has increased due to camp boundary
- Volunteer drop out due to competitive salary
- Camp-in-charges are demanding beneficiary list of case management during material support that is non-negotiable by CPSS



Challenges of the staff

- COVID-19 pandemic situation limits movement
- Camp-in-charges are demanding beneficiary list of case management during material support that is non-negotiable by CPSS
- Heavy rainfall in the camp is causing problem to visit adolescents' house
- Staff drop-out due to covid-19 transmission
- Volunteer drop out due to competitive salary
- CiC of camp-20ext restrict CNG and local transport which is create problem for staff movement
