Details of the project

With the support of PKSF and a joint venture of Coast Foundation, Value Chain Development subproject entitled “Increasing Entrepreneurial Income and Employment Creation through Expansion and Marketing of Crab Farming Technology” started on June 7, 2021. This sub-project is being implemented with a total of 2400 crab farmers, crab hunters, crab depot owners and two entrepreneur level crab hatcheries in Cox's Bazar Sadar, Chakaria, Teknaf upazila of Cox's Bazar district.

The PACE (Crab) Project is being implemented in three upazilas of Cox's Bazar district with the support of PKSF funded by IFAD and Coast Foundation initiatives to increase the income of entrepreneurs and create employment through expansion and marketing of crab farming technology. Various trainings related to Crab Farming have been organized for crab farmers, crab hunters and crab market stakeholders and service providers in teknaF Upazila. Farmer Dudu Mia's Crab Farm is located in the village of Ulobonia in teknaF.

At present it is stocked with mud crabs of various sizes. Regularly he supplies different grade crabs at various depots in Teknaf. After Covid-19 pandemic he overcame the subsequent loss and is now benefiting more financially than ever before. He applied for a grant through the project's Assistant Value Chain Facilitator. He later received a grant from the PACE Project after the screening. Utilizing the grant, he fattened crabs in his crab farm with the help of

modern techniques and techniques. In the past, he used to farming crabs in the traditional way. It is to be noted that he is aware of all the techniques and techniques of crab farming through various trainings of PACE project. He is now a successful crab farmer in the area and has become a role model for crab cultivation to everyone.
