Soft skill training for skill development of Kishor-Kishori.

Training on soft skill development was provided to presidents and members of 72 adolescent clubs of 8 unions of Lalmohan Upazila Municipality under the implementation and management of COAST Foundation in the scope of youth program and Palli Karma-Sahayak Foundation. conducted by the assistant teacher of Lalmohan Ha-Meem Reci: School and College and the Lalmohan representative of Daily Jugantor and the general secretary of Lalmohan Press Club Mr. Md. Jasim Johnny. Provides training to Kishor-Kishori on how to write a poem, essay or story. He said that before writing a story or a poem, you should first think about what topic or incident to write about, then think about when and how this incident happened. Any factors or characters are connected with the incident, and what kind of role these characters had. After that you have to start writing. At first, keep writing whatever comes to your mind, when you finish writing the first time, read it a few times and wherever you

feel a little inconsistent, change the text and add new text. Wear again, change again. After a few changes in this way, something good will be created that you will not believe yourself that you can write such a beautiful story or essay. At first you may have to write over and over again on a topic, but once you get the hang of the writing line, it won't be a problem anymore.

In writing poetry you have to think of a rhythm like 1,2,3,4-1,2,3. Again 1, 2, 3, 4-1, 2, 3 should be written along with the rhythm keeping the rhythm on the selected topic of the poem. While writing, the correctness of the spelling should be considered. In writing the combined characters, the sadhu and the current form of the language should not be mixed. If the language is active, it should be written in active form in all cases. Nowadays most of the poetry is given more priority over the prose form. So you don't have to worry about the rhythm. This month soft skill development training was provided to the youth club members of 8 unions of Lalmohan and Borhan Uddin

upazilas. Through this training, an attempt is made to

increase the writing skills of the Kishor-Kishori and to develop the latent talent in them. Today Kishor-Kishori are drifting away from writing skills due to the use of mobile phones.
